6	What are you looking for in the Risk Management Plan?	Forecasting for projected future costs so that GPMTD can use the options listed in the IFB to project GPMTD costs.
7	Would the New Vendor need to supply all the tank monitoring equipment?	No – GPMTD uses Veeder Root (TLS-250) tank monitoring system. Vendor will be required to remote into the Veeder Root system to monitor tank levels to ensure GPMTD does not run out of fuel.
8	Who owns the modem?	Vendor supplies their own modem and is responsible for maintaining. Vendor will need to provide modem, maintain, support and replace, if issues.
9	Is there remote monitoring for paratransit location?	No – There is no remote monitoring at the GPMTD ADA paratransit location.
10	Will the paratransit location be a call in situation?	No – The Vendor's delivery person monitors the tanks when delivering fuel to the GPMTD ADA paratransit location.
		There are two (2) tanks at the property. Vendor should ensure the GPMTD ADA location does not run out of fuel.
11	Tank Maintenance – what would you like to see? Full cleaning, flush, by additive?	Vendor shall perform a complete mechanical cleaning at least once a year. This includes removing all fuel, removing all items that should not be in the tanks and re-pumping fuel back into the tank(s).
12	Which tanks are to be cleaned?	The three (3) 12,000 gallon diesel tanks. GPMTD requires that tanks are kept in good condition.
