#	Questions submitted or asked	Response from GPMTD
1	What are the parking options?	<i>Parking in the adjacent lot is owned by Heartland Parking. Coordination of the use of those lost will need to be made through them.</i>
2	Where would a crane go?	<i>There is an adjacent lot next to the Transit Center, which is owned by Heartland Parking. Coordination will need to be made through Heartland Parking.</i>
3	What are your hours of operations for planning.	<i>The CityLink Rider's Guide is available to download at https://www.ridecitylink.org/schedules-routes/</i>
4	Are specific certifications required for this purchase?	<i>GPMTD is requesting a Garland Modified Bituminous Membrane Roofing System or its approved equal. Refer to Section 3-4 Approved Equals of the IFB Document. If the contractor can provide a roofing system that they believe is equal to the product specified they can complete Attachment D of the IFB document.</i>
5	Restrictions for the use of the ladder.	<i>The ladder cannot be left unattended. Barricades must be placed around the ladder when it is not in use.</i>
6	Section 00 4101 of the Project Manual, please clarify.	<i>If the contractor can provide a product of equal quality as the product being requested they would have to complete Attachment D of the IFB document. If the contractor submits the lowest bid they do not have to purchase the product as specified in Section 00 4101 of the Project Manual.</i>
