CityLink Announces the Second Public Open House Meeting for the North Side Transfer Zone Study

(PEORIA, IL) -- The Greater Peoria Mass Transit District (CityLink) will be hosting the second Public Open House on Tuesday, July 29, 2014 from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Life Together Center, First Federated Church, 3625 N. Sheridan Road (corner of Sheridan and War Memorial Drive), Peoria, IL.

The North Side Transfer Zone is a proposed designated area that will accommodate transit passenger transfers between approximately seven bus routes serving the north side of the City of Peoria. The Zone will be environmentally sustainable, implementing energy efficient building materials. The purpose of the study is to determine site location and services for the proposed Transfer Zone.

The Public Open House will be an interactive meeting to allow residents and other interested stakeholders an opportunity to hear about proposed locations for the Transfer Zone, including potential facilities and services, and share their opinions. Those interested are invited to attend any time between 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. There will be a brief presentation at 4:30 p.m. and again at 6:30 p.m.
